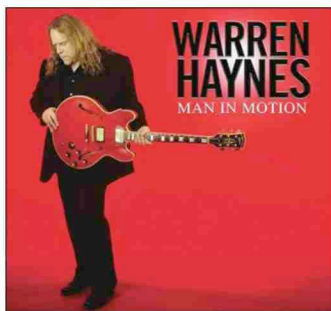

On this CD, Warren Haynes steps away from his Gov't Mule and Allman Brothers rock and toward the worlds of soul and gospel. It's a good move.

His husky voice is a great match for the material, 10 tracks of glorious bass-grooving, keyboard-pulsing, horn-punctuated, working-up-a-sweat-Lord fun.

Ron Holloway's tenor sax work deserves special praise. You'll find three lead singers on this CD: Haynes' voice, his guitar and Holloway's sax. "Sick of My Shadow" and "On a Real Lonely Night" provide uproarious interplay between the three of them that are the highlight of the album.

"Man in Motion" kicks off the CD and sets the tone - smart lyrics, sophisticated chord movement, first-class backing and generous amounts of Haynes' impassioned guitar work.

The more you listen to this CD, the more you'll find to enjoy. No doubt Haynes will return to Gov't Mule, but he formed a band for this outing that can do wonders.
